

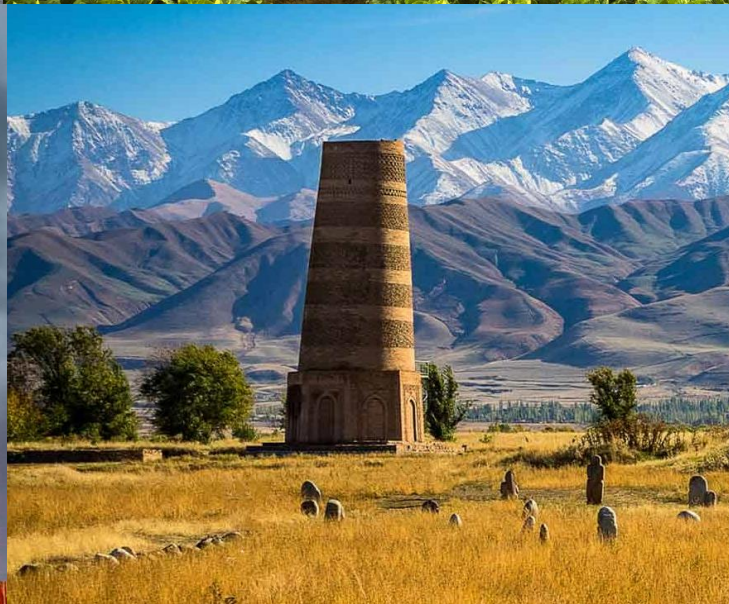
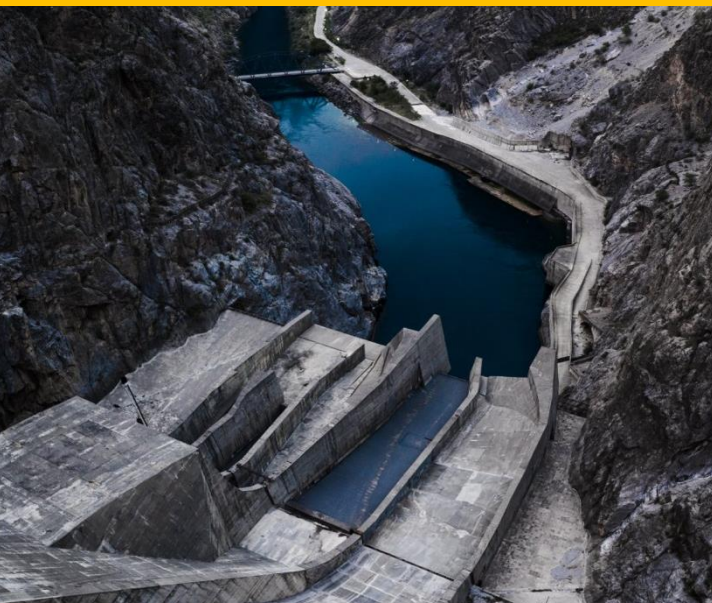

Project name:

Project of public-private partnership "Construction of the boarding house Altyn-Bulak

Brief description of the project:

Boarding house "Altyn-Bulak" has been in operation since 1975, and during the entire period of operation no major repairs were carried out. Currently, the boarding house is in need of repair.

The area of boarding house - 3,19 ha, including fixed area 2,6 ha, beach area - 0,59 ha. The boarding house is located on the shore of the ice-free Lake Issyk-Kul in the village of Sary-Oi in Issyk-Kul region. There are all necessary communications.

It is planned to build 2 buildings for 250-300 people, 14 cottages, a canteen and a conference hall.

For many years the sphere of services is one of the main sources of profit attraction. By providing quality services and creating appropriate facilities for recreation will increase the cost of services provided by the boarding house, which in turn will replenish the budget boarding house

The amount of investment - 1 million U.S. dollars

- The first 3-story building 60 double rooms;
- The second 3-story building 60 three-bed rooms;
- Conference room and dining room for 190 seats;
- Reconstruction of the beach area





State partner:

Ministry of Health of the Kyrgyz Republic (public-private partnership project)

Brief description of the project:

The goal of the project is to create computerized tomography (CT) diagnostic centers in health care organizations (Bishkek and the regions). The project can be a resource that will allow investment in infrastructure and equipment, and at the same time introduce state regulation of the cost of these services for the population.



Description of the project initiator:

There is an urgent need to provide the population of the republic with physical, economic access to CT services. Given the insufficient amount of funds allocated from the national budget, this project may become the resource that will allow to make investments in infrastructure and equipment, and at the same time introduce state regulation of the cost of these services for the population.



Public-Private Partnership Project "Installation of computer tomographs in medical and health care organizations health care organizations of the Kyrgyz Republic".

The cost of the project - about \$4.5 million

Currently prepared and approved: feasibility study, tender documentation for the selection of a private partner. The state partner is preparing to announce a tender for the selection of a private partner to implement the project

Duration of agreement: about 15 years



Project Name:

Public-Private Partnership Project "Organization of Day Care Centers for Children with Disabilities

Brief description of the project:

State Partner: Ministry of Health of the Kyrgyz Republic

Project implementation period: It is proposed to sign a PPP agreement for 10 years

It is assumed that under the project 9 rehabilitation day care centers for children with disabilities will be selected in 7 regions of the republic and the cities of Bishkek and Osh. The average number of places in each center should be from 15 to 20 places, which is about 180 children in 9 centers

These centers will be intended for children from 3 to 18 years old. It is planned that the private partner will receive state financial support for these 9 centers in the form of financing part of the costs associated with the payment of utilities and salaries of the centers' staff in the first years

The aim of the project is to create appropriate conditions for the development of children with disabilities. In the conditions of the center a child can receive social and psychological and socio-pedagogical assistance. Also the center will allow the child to get the opportunity of social adaptation to life in society to learning and work. When receiving the services of this center, a parent gets an opportunity to use this time for additional earnings. Thus, the services of the center have an impact not only for the child, but also for the family as a whole

Project Name:

Project of public-private partnership "Reconstruction and modernization of the State Enterprise "Sanatorium "Issyk-Kul Aurora"

Brief description of the project :

State partner: State Property Management Fund and State Enterprise "Issyk-Kul Aurora Sanatorium"

The reconstruction and modernization program contains several stages:

- reconstruction and modernization of the main building, treatment unit, kitchen, dining room, restaurants with the replacement of equipment, furniture, change of interior, construction of a sports complex with a stadium and running tracks,

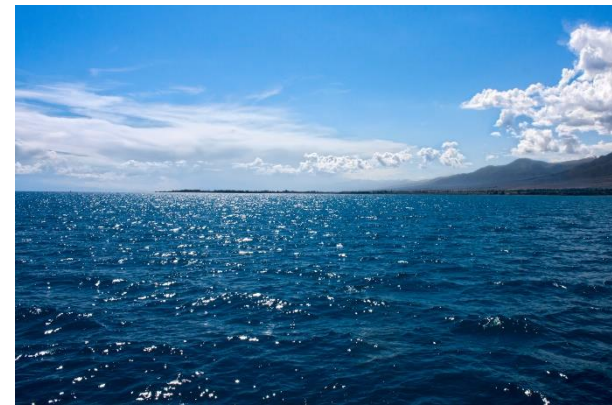
- re-equipment of the beach area with the installation of an aqua-park, reconstruction of access roads, roads, sidewalks, modernization of the irrigation system, landscape design of the park;

- Construction of one-, two-, and three-story cottages for seasonal and year-round functioning

Currently, tourism, as one of the most profitable export industries, makes a significant contribution to the economy of many countries engaged in this type of activity. The level of development of the tourism industry in the country is largely determined by various social, cultural and economic factors, the political situation and the external attractiveness of the country that receives foreign tourists and develops external tourism

Project Name:

Establishment of the Scientific Clinical and Rehabilitation High Mountain Center of the Kyrgyz State Medical Academy named after I.K. Akhunbaev. I.K. Akhunbaev

Brief description of the project:

KSMA named after I.K. Akhunbaev is one of the first universities in the Kyrgyz Republic, where specialists have mastered modern methods of treatment of many diseases, has a highly qualified staff, constantly invites highly qualified domestic and foreign specialists in various medical fields within an extensive business network

The goal of the project is to build a scientific clinical and rehabilitation high-mountain center on the Toho-Ashuu Pass to improve the health of the population of the republic and other countries in the conditions of high-mountain stationary, as well as to develop new science-based climate-environmental methods of treatment

In the practice of treatment of such diseases as bronchial asthma, hypoplastic and iron-deficient anemia, chronic leukemia, hypertension, obesity, neurocirculatory dystonia, primary thyrotoxicosis, diffuse toxic goiter and others, training patients to hypoxia in medium and high altitude conditions has long been used

Stages of implementation:

Stage 1 - Construction of scientific clinical and rehabilitation high-mountain center of NKRVTs KSMA named after I.K. Akhunbaev for 100 beds;

Stage 2 - Equipping of the center with medical, household and transport accessories;

Stage 3 - Training and specialization of doctors (including sports doctors) and auxiliary medical personnel for work on rehabilitation of patients in the high-mountain center

Project name:

Modernization of the Bar-Bulak recreation center (Bar-Bulak village, Ton district)

Brief description of the project :

Health Center "Bar-Bulak" is different from other spas for its hot baths, which have unique healing properties

On the territory of the center there is a hot spring, which refers to the thermal waters. The temperature of the water varies between 40-42 degrees Celsius. In terms of composition, the water is mineral drinking therapeutic table water and is close to the unique Alma-Ata type in terms of chemical composition.

Water cures the following diseases:

- Diseases of the musculoskeletal system;
- Diseases of the gastrointestinal tract;
- Chronic gastritis, ulcers;
- Diabetes mellitus;
- Diseases of the genitourinary system;
- Bronchitis and asthma

The center is located on the shore of Lake Issyk-Kul

Current status:

The center provides treatment, accommodation and meals. The cost of treatment for one person is 1500 soms per day

The amount of investment - \$670 thousand

- Completion of the construction of a hotel with 100 beds - \$300 thousand.
- Construction of a 50m swimming pool - \$350,000.
- Landscaping of the territory - \$20 th.
