



## **RESOLUTION OF THE GOVERNMENT OF THE KYRGYZ REPUBLIC**

No. 503, dated October 28, 2018

### **On Determining Priority Activities /Economy Sectors of Investment Projects**

To apply the preferential tariffs established by subparagraph 7.1.11 of paragraph 7 of the Decision No. 130 of the Customs Union Committee on November 27, 2009, in accordance with Articles 10 and 17 of the Constitutional Law of the Kyrgyz Republic "On Government of the Kyrgyz Republic", the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic

HEREBY RESOLVES:

1. To establish the following priority activities/ sectors of the economy with regard to which the preferential tariffs established by subparagraph 7.1.11 of paragraph 7 of the Decision No.130 of the Customs Union Committee dated November 27, 2009, shall apply:

- 1) industrial production based on innovative technologies;
- 2) light industry;
- 3) food industry;
- 4) energy industry;
- 5) agriculture, production and processing of agricultural products;
- 6) assembly industry;
- 7) tourism;
- 8) export-oriented manufacturing;
- 9) communication networks and switching systems;
- 10) road transport and road construction;
- 11) banking and payment activities;
- 12) health care (medical equipment, including components and spare parts, as well as medical devices);
- 13) air transport (civil passenger airplanes).

2. The Investments Promotion and Protection Agency of the Kyrgyz Republic shall:

- Make a register of investment projects corresponding to the priority activities (sectors of economy), in accordance with the criteria established by the second paragraph of subparagraph 7.1.11, para 7 of the Decision No. 130 of the Customs Union Committee on November 27, 2009, in the form as attached in Annex to this Resolution;
- Send the register of investment projects to the Office of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic, the State Customs Service under the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic.

3. The Department of Economy and Investment of the Government of the Kyrgyz Republic shall be in charge of supervising the implementation of this Resolution.
4. This Resolution shall be officially published and shall come into force on the date of its signing.
